

It's well known that Santa Rosa offers cool things for water lovers. But history buffs and shutterbugs looking for unusual shots will also be rewarded in our community. Be sure your camera's charged before you set out to discover our past and see all the new development initiatives we have going:

- Historic Route 66 is still alive with an auto museum and well-preserved neon from the '30s to '60s.
- MainStreet/4th Street is being brought back to the glory of the railroad era.
- Ilfeld Warehouse, once a center of regional commerce is being restored for new uses.
- The completion of the Courthouse Square landscape project will return many community activities and events to MainStreet and the historic Court House will once again find use as the center of county government.

If you have questions on finding your way around Santa Rosa, ask the experts at our visitor center, located temporarily in City Hall at 244 South 4th Str. In 2009 it will move to the refurbished Ilfeld Warehouse on Main Street by the railway track.
